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The following outline is recommended in order to complete the work for this class in a time frame of August (typically when the Pathfinder year begins) to March 1st. By following this format, an instructor should be able to complete the work without rushing to fit in those last minute items. The schedule can be adapted to your needs, keeping the goal in mind of having a steady, structured plan of completion. This will help avoid those “*Last Minute*” problems. The instruction will not be as effective if you are in a rush to get it done.

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FRIEND INSTRUCTOR'S OUTLINE

Instructor's Tips:

Do not use phrases like "Home Work" and "Class Work". Say "Progressive Ranks", or "We will be working on (blank) Honor".
The thought of having to do more home work in addition to what they have to do for school will do little for the enthusiasm of your students.

Begin long activities as early as possible in the year.

Provide progress reports to the coordinator, and advise the coordinator of problems.

Seek guidance and assistance from other instructors and leaders.

Pay attention to group activities. They may fulfill some of the class requirements.

Complete as many of the honors started by your group during this class as you can. Many areas build on honors and future class ranks.

- HEALTH AND FITNESS III B (Completed in school-Public and Private)

DECEMBER

- SERVING OTHERS I (Should be completed as part of Sabbath School. If member does not attend Sabbath School, then complete within the club)
- SERVING OTHERS III (Completed as a planned Share Your Faith activity)
- YOUTH ORGANIZATION III A&B (Completed during normal Pathfinder activities)
- CONTINUE WORKING ON PROJECTS STARTED IN NOVEMBER

JANUARY

- HEALTH AND FITNESS I A&B (B – An educational visit from D.A.R.E. or other similar group should be scheduled for the club)
- HEALTH AND FITNESS II A&B (A – use one or more TLT members to teach this)
- OUTDOOR LIVING I A&B
- HONOR ENRICHMENT I A (Completed during normal Pathfinder activities)

FEBRUARY

- NATURE STUDY I (On a club Campout during Sabbath worship or Unit worship)
- OUTDOOR LIVING II (Will be completed on activity days and camps)
- HONOR ENRICHMENT II A&B (B – May have been completed in school or summer camp)
- MAKING FRIENDS I
- NATURE STUDY III (Normal Pathfinder activity)
